This week classes are working on their 'props' and costumes for Winterfest as well as practicing for their performance, and again the many talents in our school community are shining through. A huge thanks to parents who have been helping out in the classrooms in various ways, to those who decorated the hall and to the entire staff who gave up many extra hours over the last few weeks to prepare costumes, stage sets, backdrop, props, music and everything else necessary for a whole school performance.

Sound System Upgrade

Our sound system has been upgraded thanks to the generosity of the sound company Sound Lease, who have deferred payment until January. The new system, including new speakers and mics, has really enhanced the sound experience for the children. The upgrade has cost €2,600 in total. So far we have raised €800 through online donations on Eventbrite but many parents have said they prefer to donate in-school, so we appeal to those who can to please give generously at the door to help meet the cost of the sound system upgrade.
