Getting in the light


In 2000 I was 12 and still living in Mayo. One day my parents were going to a conference in Dublin. I was going to be staying at my Granny and Granddads house.

One day whilst she was ironing us 5 were sitting around her listing to a story about the farm animals.




My mother who was also getting very excited now said, "and what about equipment for the farm"?. "Aahh i know what i am going to get"?.
