Report to the School Community

Education (Admissions to Schools) Act 2018:

A number of sections of the above act relating to school admission policies and processes have been commenced. All boards of management must draft a new admission policy in accordance with the act's requirements following consultation with the patron, the staff of the school and parents of current pupils. Guidance will be provided by both the Department of Education and Skills and by our patron body, Educate Together.

The new legislation requires that the Board of Management submit a revised Admissions Policy to Educate Together by 1st May 2020.

Development/Fundraising:

The Board was briefed on the upcoming OsKars fundraising event on Saturday 16th May in Fitzpatrick Castle Hotel, Killiney. There will be an information evening for the event in the 5th Class room on Thursday 27th February.

School Policies & Procedures:

A review of school policies and procedures has commenced and revised policies will be posted on the school website when completed. The first policy to be reviewed is the ICT Acceptable Use Policy for our pupils.

School Fire Alarm System:

Although replacing them is expensive we believe it is a necessary upgrade. A vendor has been selected following a recent procurement process and the cost will be approximately €5,500.
