
### 3: Christmas characters

### Rice Krispies buns



Younger kids 5 - 7 These are super simple and easy although you will need supervision while using the hob.

INGREDIENTS : Rice Krispies 200g, Marshmallows 225g, 55g Butter, Food colouring 3 drops green or red, Sprinkles,



EQUIPMENT: Large Bowl, Saucepan, Wooden spoon/ spatula, Cookie cutter, optional, Tray. Gently melt marshmallows and butter over a low heat in your pan, take off the heat move to your bowl then add the food colouring to the marshmallows mix and then add rice Krispies quickly .Put in to the tray and leave to cool in the fridge □

When they're cool take out of the fridge and cut into shapes of your choice e.g. Christmas trees. And enjoy!



**Sugar Cookies** 8-12 These delicious and sweet sugar cookies are perfect for any event.

**INGREDIENTS**  
96 grams of plain flour,  
½ teaspoon baking powder,  
1 pinch of salt, 60 grams  
of unsalted butter (at room  
temperature), 50 grams of  
sugar, 1 large egg yolk, ½  
teaspoon of vanilla extract



For the icing  
125g of icing sugar, 2-3 tablespoons of icing sugar, One drop of vanilla extract, Sprinkles for decoration

**EQUIPMENT:** Rolling pin, Baking tray, Small bowl, Whisk, Electric whisk, Medium bowl, Cookie cutters of your choice we are using snowman

**METHOD**  
1. Preheat your oven to 160 degrees  
2. Line your baking tray with parchment paper or a silicone baking mat  
3. In a small bowl whisk together flour baking powder and salt  
4. In a medium sized bowl beat together the butter and sugar together with an electric mixer.  
5. Once light and fluffy beat the in the egg yolk and extracts  
6. Once they are well incorporated then sprinkle in the butter mixture into half of the flour mixture. Gradually add in the rest of the flour mixture. Refrigerate until hard enough to roll.  
7. roll out until 1/2 inch thick. Using a shape cookie cutter of your choice, cut out the cookies.  
8. Put them into the oven for 10 minutes or until lightly golden in colour.  
9. Allow to cool.  
Mix up the icing ingredients. Spread or pipe onto the cold cookies.  
Enjoy!
