Public Health Reminders

- Symptoms – Children should not attend school if they have any symptoms of Covid-19 infection.
- Symptomatic household members - No-one should be attending school if they have any household member who has signs or symptoms of Covid-19; they should be restricting their movements until it is clear whether the household member has Covid-19 infection or not.
- Close contacts need to restrict their movements and undergo testing if they have been told by their doctor / HSE services that they are a close contact of a case of Covid-19; they should not be attending any school.
- Re-enforcing general public health messages - Please remember the importance of keeping our school safe by abiding by the national public health measures currently in place at all times e.g. restricting movements and social contacts, social distancing, use of facial coverings and hand hygiene

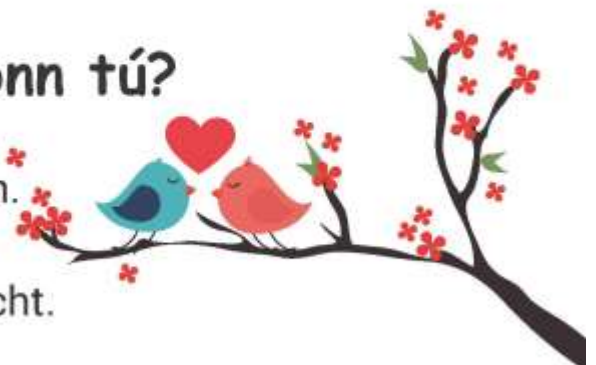
