If we have wet weather, the assembly will take place in the hall and unfortunately, parents / guardians will be unable to attend.



Nurturing Nest - A Programme for Parents / Guardians

With Parent Mentors Ber Carroll and Gabrielle O'Herlihy

The aim of the programme is to support parents/guardians in creating a nurturing, caring environment for their children, while focussing at the same time on their own self-care.

Four Thursday evenings, Thursday, 10 November - Thursday, 1 December.

7.30 pm - 9 pm every evening

Ber and Gabrielle have designed two programmes, *Always a Star Wellbeing Programme* for infant classes and *The Nurturing Nest Programme* for parents/guardians.

In addition to providing support to parents/ guardians, the programme also provides a great opportunity for parents/ guardians to get to know each other at the start of their children's journey in RETNS.

However, this programme would be very well-suited not just to parents of infants, but to all parents / guardians as Ber and Gabrielle discuss with participants questions such as

- · How can I help my child who is struggling with anxiety without becoming anxious myself?
- · How can I understand the meaning and purpose of my child's challenging behaviours and struggles?
- · How can I encourage my child to listen to me?
- · How can I create boundaries for my child especially around social media and use of screens?

We don't have as much fun as we used to. Can you help me to play with my child? \dots
