# Hallowe'en Assembly

We have spoken to the children about appropriate costumes. They are aware of the guidelines below. Please talk to your child about these.

- Costumes should be comfortable, children should be able to use the bathroom easily and costumes should not be so long that children will be in danger of tripping over.
- High heels are not suitable as they are dangerous on stairs and yard. Children should wear comfortable shoes such as runners
- No guns or sharp weapons.
- Children may bring their own wipes to remove make-up.


All children are invited to make a contribution of €2, which will be donated to Educate Together as part of their 'One Day Together' annual fundraising campaign.



## **Nurturing Nest - A Programme for Parents / Guardians**

Thank you to the parents/ guardians who have expressed an interest in the Nurturing Nest Programme for parents / guardians. We still need some more parents to make the programme viable. If you are interested, please contact Carol by tomorrow morning.

The aim of the programme is to support parents/guardians in creating a nurturing, caring environment for their children, while focussing at the same time on their own self-care.

Four Thursday evenings, Thursday, 10 November - Thursday, 1 December.

#### 7.30 pm – 9 pm every evening

In addition to providing support to parents/ guardians, the programme also provides a great opportunity for newer parents/ guardians to get to know each other at the start of their children's journey in RETNS.

However, this programme would be very well-suited not just to parents of infants, but to all parents / guardians as Ber and Gabrielle discuss with participants questions such as

- · How can I help my child who is struggling with anxiety without becoming anxious myself?
- · How can I understand the meaning and purpose of my child's challenging behaviours and struggles?
- · How can I encourage my child to listen to me?
- · How can I create boundaries for my child especially around social media and use of screens?
