## **Voluntary Contributions**

Any amounts above or below the suggested level are gratefully received and will go towards running the school and enhancing the children's learning environment and experiences. Payments can be made via Aladdin. A payment request will be sent out tomorrow. If you would prefer to set up a standing order, please contact Carol.
