A reminder that any exchange of gifts between children, including Secret Santas, should be done outside school. This is something that can cause upset for some children so your cooperation would be much appreciated.

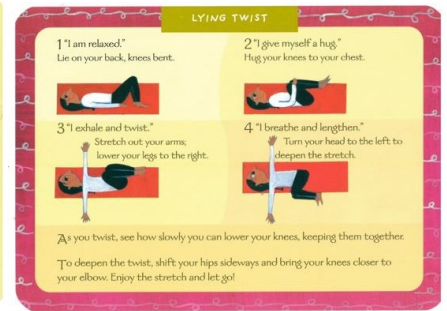
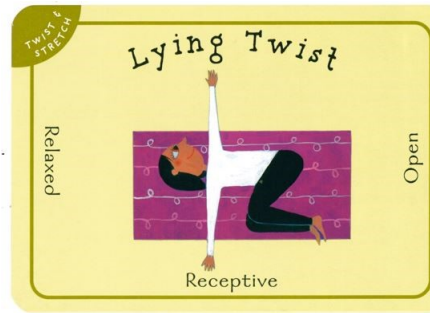
Frásaí na Seachtaine –
