Message from Cybersafe Kids

We are delighted to share our new online safety parental awareness campaign 'Same Rules Apply', which we are launching as part of Safer Internet Day. In partnership with the National Parents Council and supported by Accenture, this campaign highlights the need to approach parenting children 'online' in the same way that we approach parenting them 'offline'. Our video challenges the arbitrary distinction between 'offline' and 'online' worlds asking, "As parents, we'd never allow this to happen offline, so why allow it online? Giving your child unsupervised access to the online world means you're also giving the online world unsupervised access to your child. Remember, online or offline, Same Rules Apply."

As part of the campaign, we have created a new interactive Digital Parenting guide in association with the Irish Examiner, National Parents Council and Accenture. Digital Parenting: Keeping your Kids Safe Online will help parents provide the support and care their children need to navigate the online world safely.
