Educate Together

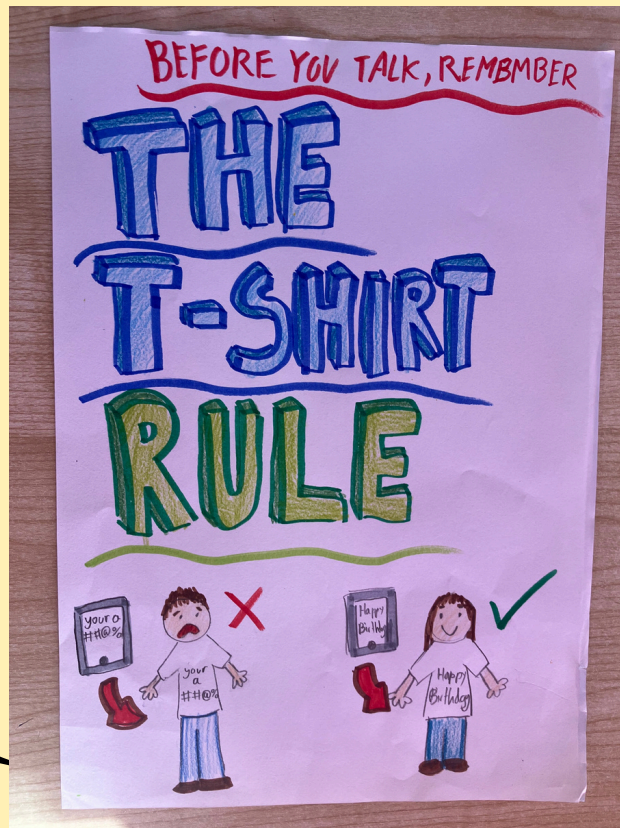
One Day Together

Walking Bus



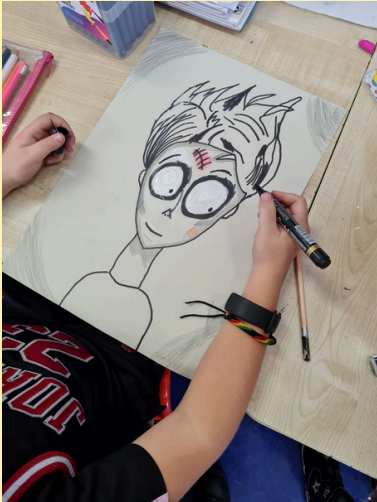
The Walking Bus is on this Friday 8th November.
